Dear Parents and Carers,

A warm welcome back to a new school year. It has been so lovely to have all the children and staff back to school and finding out what they have been up to over the summer break. Can we ask that for pick up that class 2 parents make their way down the left-hand side of the lane, towards the side gate of the playground as very often staff cannot see parents if they are waiting at the top. Class 1 children will continue to enter and exit through the main entrance, with parents waiting outside for pick up. Once again, many thanks for your continual support.

New Reception Children

A big warm welcome to our new reception children who have settled into class 1 beautifully. They have shown fantastic listening skills as well as great collaboration in our new builders' yard in our role play area. If you have any materials or toys that could

Behaviour Reward System

This week the children have had discussions about 'yes please' and 'no thank you' behaviour choices and established classroom rules in order to keep everyone safe whilst at school. The children have created their own classroom rules which will be displayed next week. They have also begun collecting their gold stars for demonstrating 'yes please' behaviour.

We will be rewarding certificates to the children for their efforts:

50 gold stars = bronze certificate

100 gold stars = silver certificate

200 gold stars = gold certificate

300 gold stars = platinum certificate

Children can receive gold stars throughout the day from all members of staff for displaying a wide range of 'yes please' behaviour choices.



Reading With Your Child at Home

Your child/ren will have come home with a reading book or several books to share with you at home. We are asking that the children read every day to an adult, even if they are a developed or free reader. Our parents reading support guide has lots of ideas and suggested questions to ask your children as they are reading to check their understanding, make careful predictions and discuss character & plot. These are skills that can only be developed through discussion and understanding of what they are reading. Your child/ren will also have a reading record book. We ask that after hearing your child read that you record your comments in this book. Staff will collect in reading record books every Tuesday and Thursday and gold stars will be rewarded for their reading at home. Tuesdays and Thursdays will also be the day when we change over books for the children.



Weekly PE Lessons

Both classes will have weekly PE lessons each Friday afternoon. To accommodate our health and safety assessment and ease the transition between lessons, we are asking that the children come to school each Friday in their PE kit and trainers with their school jumper or cardigan. As the weather is beginning to change, we ask that children wear tracksuit bottoms as our PE lessons will take place outside.

Parents Meetings

Over the next few weeks staff will be carrying out assessments of all the children so we can plan specific 'keep up' sessions and support all children with their knowledge and understanding of the curriculum. Our parent's meetings will be held remotely through a 15-minute 'Microsoft Teams' meeting and will take place the week beginning Monday 12th October. We hope that collaborating together with parents, we can help to support your child/ren to '*Let their Light Shine*' and strive to be the best that they can be. More information on how to sign up for a slot with your child's class teacher will be available in next week's newsletter.

Forest School

Forest School will continue this year every Thursday with class 2 having their session in the morning and class 1 in the afternoon. We are asking that children bring in their wellies to be left in school for the half term. These will be stored outside in our new forest school shed. If you have any resources (wood, pallets etc) that would be useful for our sessions, please see Mr Thomas.



Swimming

This year our swimming sessions will take place after the October half term, with class 2 swimming for the first 7 sessions and Class 1 following in January. More information on this will be available shortly.

Clothing

Please can all children bring a coat to school daily and wear their school jumper as the school can feel quite chilly due to the windows being open for ventilation. A drinks bottle will also be required daily and can be re-filled with water, should a child require a top up.
