#### **Educatering School Meals**



Effective from September, we will using catering



along with the new menu was emailed out to parents on Thursday but this can also be found on the school website.

The Department for Education has increased the funding for Free School Meals by 7p to £2.53. This recognises the increase in the cost of ingredients nationally. In line with this from September a main meal and dessert will now be charged at £2.53 per day.

To help us manage food waste and costs more effectively, Educatering will also be introducing the requirement to book <u>meals a week ahead</u>. These orders will need to be placed by **midnight the Thursday preceding the following week**. For example, the meal choices for the week starting on the 11th of September will need to be made by Thursday 7th September. Any orders placed for the coming week after 9am each Thursday, will not be counted and you may still be charged.

In the first few weeks we will send text reminders to parents, while we adjust to this new way of booking school meals.

Once again, thank you all so much for your continual support in my time at Northlew and Ashbury. Wishing you and your families a restful and enjoyable summer break. The staff are looking forward to inviting the children back to school on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> September at 8:45am. *Mrs Cook* 

#### <u>Wake Park</u>


