Dear parents/carers,

Last week's attendance was: 97.6%

This week it was lovely to see our intervention small group activities in full flow. The children are fully engaging in a wide range of maths, handwriting and reading challenges that are helping to support them with their learning in the classroom. These intervention activities are a short 20 minute focused learning, based on the targets which we sent home to parents before the Easter holidays. Staff are already seeing some of the children consolidating number facts and phonics sounds through these small focus groups. Please continue to support your child with their targets by carrying out the activities suggested by staff during the parent consultations.

Last week, staff have begun their 'Nurture Groups' with small groups of children from across the school. These groups are an opportunity for the children to come together and enables them to discuss how they are feeling whilst taking part in a range of activities such as Fun Fit PE, Crafts & Gardening. Staff have been collecting lots of photographs and quotes from the children taking part in these groups, which we hope to share with you shortly when parents can return to school. We feel that these nurture groups are vital to the mental health and wellbeing of our children. A child who feels good in themselves, is ready to learn and able to succeed.

To mark the events of the last year, the School Council decided that they would like to create their own time capsule to bury in the spiritual area when it is

completed. They plan to discuss what they will put in the capsule during next week's meeting.

Super Learner's of the Week!


Class 1


