Dear Parents/Carers,

This week the children have been focusing on 'What is an active learner? 'and 'What does an active learner do?'. The children have been demonstrating their independence in learning using resources and manipulatives to support their problem solving, looking back on previous learning to support their thinking and talking to their peers to discuss their next steps to complete a task. They have also explored different things that could be barriers to learning such as becoming easily distracted by others, not being resilient when learning becoming challenging and relying on adults to help them complete an activity. Active learning will continue to be discussed with all children across the school and makes part of the focus for all adults when supporting children with their learning.
