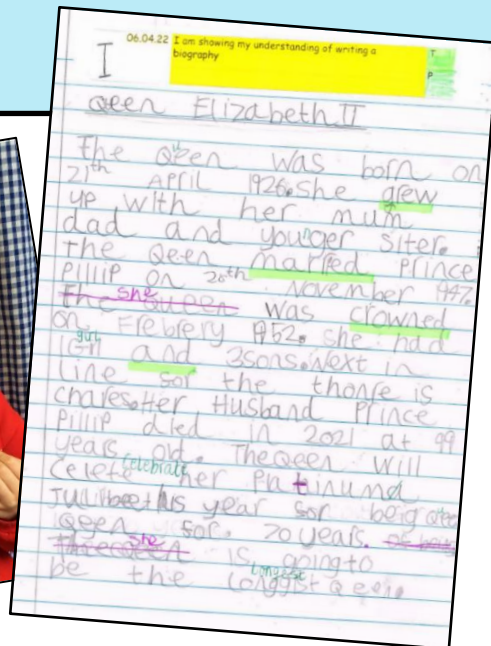

Class 2

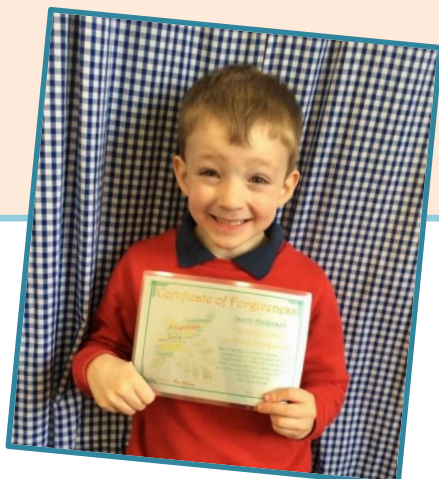
