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Dear parents/carers,

After consolation with our health and safety lead for the MAT, next week we will be opening 5 days a week to facilitate learning to more children. School is full on all 5 days with 4 children based in class 1 and a further 5 children in class 2. For those children who will be returning to school on Monday for the first time, we ask that your child/ren come to school in school uniform (unless they have out grown it). If this is the case we ask that they come in comfortable clothing suitable to move around in as they could be participating in PE lessons throughout the day.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch, drinks bottle, sun hat and coat. Our 2 m social distancing rules still apply at present in school and children will be placed in a 'bubble' with other children and adults for the whole day. They will be asked to work from their own workstation and will be provided with their own set of resources, so do not need to bring pencils and pens from home. All the children will be provided with a laptop to access our remote learning on class dojo and staff will be available in each room to help support children with this learning.

Break times and lunchtimes will be spent within their own class 'bubble' and even when the children are on the playground they will be asked to keep the 2m distancing from other children within their bubble. The children already attending school have come up with creative games and activities to do on the playground whilst keeping their 2m distance from their peers.

We ask that parents use the line markings outside the school to follow our 2m distancing rules when dropping their children off at 8:45am and school pick up at 3:30pm. From next week, children who will be working in class 2 bubble will be sent to access their classroom down the lane and through the fire door in class 2. Only children who are in class 1 bubble will access the building through the main front door. This is to prevent a large group of children accessing the building at once.

Have you met a new challenge and conquered it?


