Staff are working hard to continue with the curriculum and educate your children as best as we can remotely and with the limited resources that we have. If you are finding that your child is struggling with a particular aspect of the learning, please do let us know and we will try our best to accommodate their needs in an alternative way.

As you can appreciate staff are receiving learning remotely on a daily basis. We feel that it is extremely important to respond to as many of these pieces and give the children and parents some instant feedback. However, sometimes this may not be possible or there maybe too many pieces to mark through in one evening, but please be reassured that all learning is being looked at but may not necessarily be commented on. As children are uploading their learning tasks straight onto the dojo site it has been agreed at a recent heads of school meeting that we no longer require parents to complete a weekly time table as the evidence of children's learning is clear to see.

Reading is extremely important and we ask parents to continue with this as much as possible please. Can we ask that you continue to complete your child/ren's reading records which will be helpful for staff when the children return to school. Finally, we have had several parents who have contacted us to say that their children have almost completed their exercise book they were given when the school was closed. I have spoken to Liz our cleaner, who will this evening, leave a box of exercise books at the front of the school in a box. Please feel free to come down and help yourself if you need one.
